#### 1 MINUTES

#### 5 <u>HS2</u>

# 6 <u>**B5569**</u>

Mrs McNulty forwarded to the Chairman an e-mail she sent to PCSO Emma Darroch reporting speeding and asked about flashing 30mph signs to be positioned either end of the B5569 in Mere.

The Clerk has e-mailed PCSO Darroch asking for her opinion upon the effectiveness of such signs but has not received any reply.

The above plus many other issues relating to the B5569 in Mere have been put toMr Simon Skates, Cheshire East Council but no progress is being made. Cllr Wright proposedand Cllr Norcott seconded that Mere PC write to the newly elected Cheshire East Councilleader and send a copy to Esther McVey MP stating that Mere PC is very disappointed withthe way in which it operates.
